College Campus Ministry

For the first time ever, Ascending Leaders is serving a college campus ministry with:

- an assessment of their discipleship strength at the beginning and end of the year
- training for their small-group leaders about discipleship by the stages



OCT

International Discipleship Blossoms

- Last year was the first full year of our international work.
 Our discipleship coaches in a closed country served many more people than expected. They taught 65 leaders from 15 small rural churches with discipleship concepts.
- In 2023, they will conduct a discipleship workshop for over 25 pastors.
- This ministry is happening under the shadow of persecution.




Costs of 2022 Ministry
